The notice will be posted in all public places in every towns and villages of these applicant communities and adjacent communities. After the 30 days' notice, the FDA will work with each community to find a suitable date and time for the next step 7 (No Objection).

Therefore, every member of the above communities are encouraged to please checked at every public places to view the notice. The notice contain phone numbers of both the community representative and the FDA that could be used to seek any clarification about the process.

Meanwhile, all adjacent communities and community members in the areas where the Posting of 30 days' Notice and the Social Economic & Reconnaissance Survey (SER) and Demarcation will take place are encouraged to please take note and cooperate with the FDA.

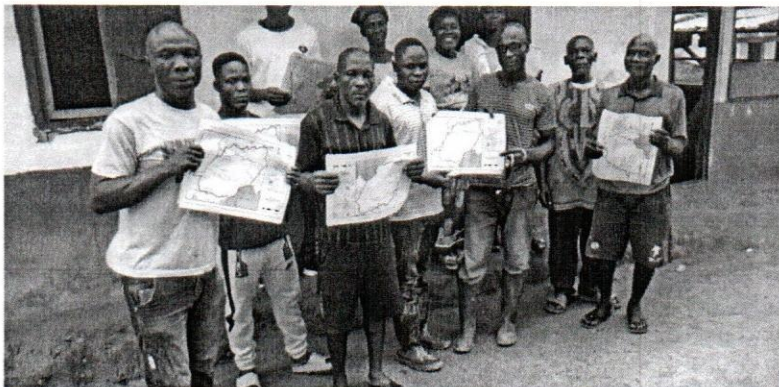

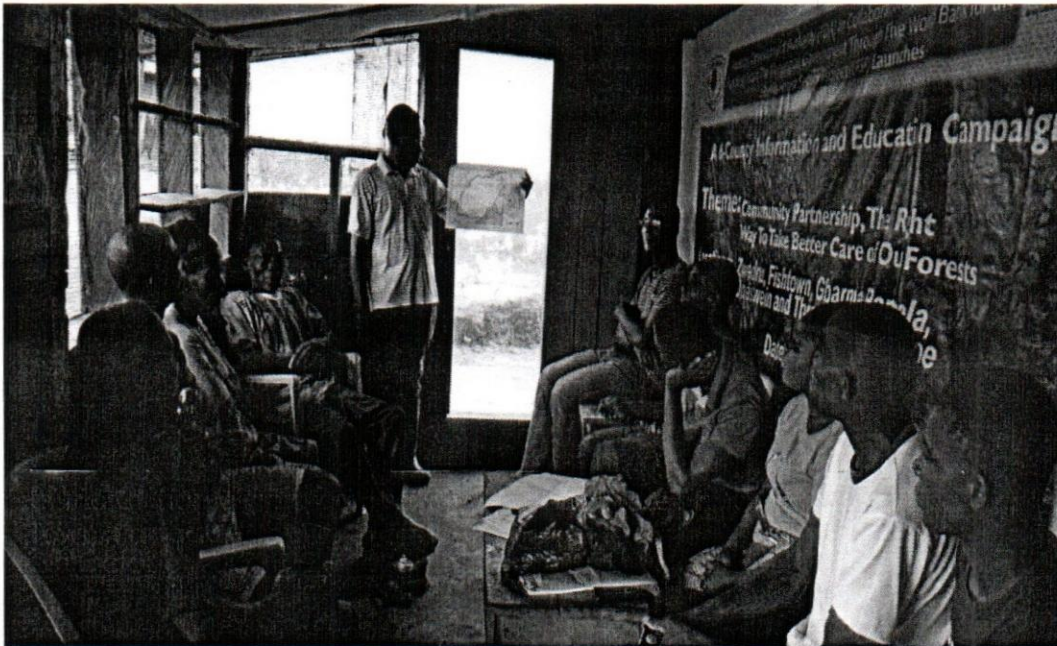
This report under review covers activities marking the Posting of result of Soci-Economic Survey and Resource Reconnaissance and Validation of **Central River Dugbe** applicant community forests in fulfillment of step six (6) of the CRL and its Regulations. The Posting was conducted on October 20-22, 2021 in Karquekpo Town, Dugbe Statutory District. Herein is an attachment of the report to be perused.



## Introduction

On October 20-22, 2021, a team from the region departed Greenville for Central River Dugbe Community forest to facilitate the posting results of **Validation and Social Economic Survey & Resource Reconnaissance Results to Establish an Authorized Forest Community** located in Sinoe County found boundary with three Community Forests namely; Lower Jloh CF in Grand Kru, Dweoh Jaedea and Fenjal in Sinoe.

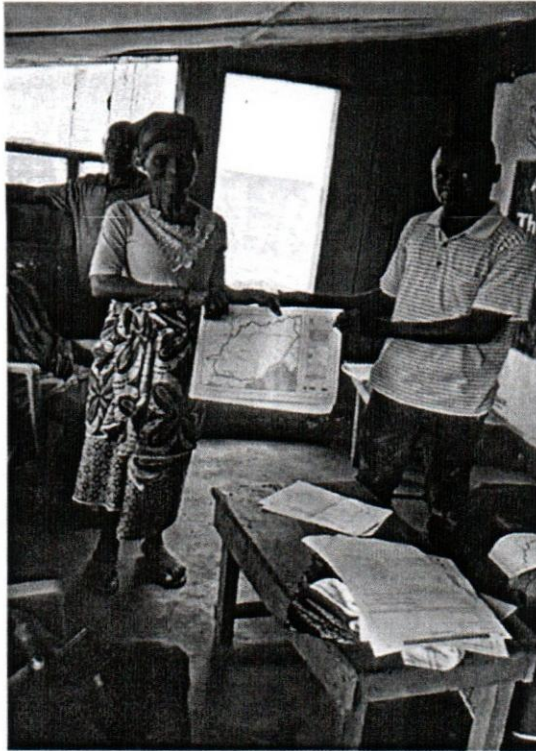
After delivering a letter to the Superintendent of the county **Hon. Lee Nagbe Chea**. The next day the team arrived in Karquekpo Town where the meeting was held for the posting. Participants from various towns/villages of the applicant communities gathered at town halls where subsequent introduction and objective of the visits were done by the facilitator; the exercise was in two phases but at once. Phase one (1) has to do with the posting of the SER Survey result while phase two (2) was Posting of the Validation result as well. These results will be posted for thirty days which is step six (6) of the nine steps of the CRL. The Central River Dugbe CF comprises of 8 towns and cities that made up of the CF namely; Karquekpo city, Swenpo, Poly's town, Siekeh Town, Jay's Town, Kabada, Weatuzon and Kaykpo.



## Objective

The objective of the exercises is in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 10, of the Community Rights Law (CRL) and its Regulations, which provides that both SER & Validation result must be posted for thirty days in the given Communities and adjacent Communities prior to the dispute resolution.





## Methodology

The methods used by the team during the exercises were the Community Entry methods and the Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) tools.

These include;

- Met with Local authorities and informed them about the Mission.
- Delivered letters from the Managing Director of FDA to the Local Authority
- Held town hall meetings (for Posting SER & Validation results for the establishment of an authorized community forest status)
- Entertained Questions and Answers for clarity
- Posting SER & Validation results to be reviewed for 30 days
- On the 20<sup>th</sup> of October 2021 an announcement was place up for the Posting of 30 days' notices of Social Economic Survey and Resource Reconnaissance (SESRR) and Preliminary Demarcation map results this announcement was place at the Liberty Broadcasting System FM 105.5 in Greenville, Sinoe County.

## Proceedings

The team left Greenville City and arrived in Karquekpo City on October 20, 2021. The next morning, we proceeded to the meeting hall where the community members had gathered at the meeting hall for the meeting. Prominent persons from the applicant community that were present in the meeting included the Paramount Chief of welcome the citizen and guest to the meeting.

The meeting opened with a pray and welcome remarks. The FDA staff Mr. Johnson read out the SESRR summary. He pointed out to them that all information in the summary was information the community people themselves provided during the survey. The community people all agreed to the information in the summary; that every other information therein corresponds to what they provided during the SER.

He later took the floor to explain the map to them. They accepted the results according to the map but pointed out some observations. They observed that the SERR never included Kaykpo in the number of towns that comprises the Community Forest so the community raise the concern and told the FDA to add Kaykpo. Team promised to check with the department to ratify their concerns.

Sets of copies of the map and the SESRR summary were distributed to each representative of the affected towns and villages. The posting was launched and the results posted in Henry town for thirty (30) days in the presence of the local authorities and the concerned community members. The community representatives were instructed to continue the posting and explanation of the result and villages; they should post them at key points in adjacent communities where those who were not present during the exercise, will be able to see the two results.

The posting lasted from the 20<sup>th</sup> of October 2021 and ended the October 22, 2021 and we told them if there is any problem or concern they should raise it within the 30 days so we can settle it in step 7 before going on with the governance structure elections. The posting started October 20, 2021 and the 30 days' notices should expire November 20, 2021. The CFOC leadership headed by Mr. Bartee Togba help in mobilization and organization of the posting of the results.

At the end of the exercises, the community members and local leaders lauded the FDA team for the education on the various steps of the CRL which gave rise to the Social Economic Survey and validation results, one of the procedures leading to communities' forest status. Mr. Bartee Togba promised that they will do everything they can to disseminate the documents to each and every town and village concerned so that they view it in the thirty (30) day period. He said that he hopes FDA responds to their call to move to next step immediately after the 30 days' elapses.





### **Observations**

- Community representatives complained about transportation and feeding.
- The long gap in time from previous step reduces the community people's interest to some extent.

### **Constraints**

- Bad road condition in this rainy season.
- Inadequate mobilization of community for the meeting.

### **Recommendations**

- That adequate mobilization be carryout before the at least a day or two before SER & validation results are taken to them for posting.
